In the US he's best known for the song *Fool (If You Think It's Over)*, which reached No. 12 on the Billboard Hot 100 during 1978, spending 3 weeks on top of the Adult Contemporary chart, leading to a Grammy nomination as Best New Artist the following year. Rea had sold over 30 million L.P.s worldwide by 2009.
