Bringing these thinkers together and interlinking their ideas, Lambert Wiesing presents an engaging history of formal aesthetics, while reconstructing the philosophical foundations for the appearance of new image forms in the 20th century, including

the video-clip, abstract collage, digital simulation and virtual reality. Using this original approach, *The Visibility of the Image* introduces the rise of modern image theory and provides a valuable account of our engagement with pictures in the 21st century.
