Rea was one of the most popular British singer-songwriters of the late '80s, already being a major European star when he entered the UK Top 10 with the issue of the single The Road to Hell (Part 2),

his 18th chart entry. Two of his studio LPs, *The Road to Hell* and *Auberge*, topped the UK Albums Chart. Chris was nominated in 3 consecutive years for the Brit Award for Best British Male Artist, from 1988 - 1990. His hits include *I Can Hear Your Heartbeat*, *Stainsby Girls*, *Josephine*, *On the Beach*, *Let's Dance*, *Driving Home for Christmas*, *Working on It*, *Tell Me There's a Heaven*, *Auberge*, *Looking for*

the Summer, *Winter Song*, *Nothing to Fear*, *Julia*, and *If You Were Me*, a duet with Elton John. In the US he's best known for the song *Fool (If You Think It's Over)*, which reached No. 12 on the *Billboard Hot 100* during 1978, spending 3 weeks on top of the *Adult Contemporary* chart, leading to a Grammy nomination as *Best New Artist* the following year. Rea had sold over 30 million L.P.s

worldwide by 2009.
