Word Puzzles: These are of many different types, ranging from simple riddles that ask you to complete common words, to complex exercises where you have to unscramble the letters of a ten letter word to make another ten letter word. The only way to get better at solving these quickly is to practice a few different formats till you build up speed. This book will definitely help you!
5. Series completion quiz questions: These could be related to words, numbers, pattern recognition, or general knowledge. This book has a few

problems of this type, as well!
