From Specification Through Refinement to Implementation

This dissertation is a two part study which examines and compares two of the most common Enterprise Integration technologies: Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) and Enterprise Application Integration (EAI). The first part examines the perceptions of individuals toward each of the technologies. The second part of the study compares and contrasts the two Enterprise Integration technologies with respect to the factors leading to success (or failure). The model determines three levels of factors and is derived from the

two-factor motivational studies of Herzberg and Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs. In addition, it attempts to discover which groups of factors may be more important for explaining the variance in implementation success, leading to a more theoretically compelling model than previously available. Finally, there is a re-examination of the factor groups to determine if different factor groups are more or less important for implementation success of each of the two integration technologies.

Policy and Implementation of Juvenile Justice

This paper presents calculations of the efficiency with which value-added taxes are collected in five transition economies in Central and Eastern Europe. Actual

VAT revenues in 1994 are compared with those that would have resulted if the statutory VAT rates had been applied without any revenue leakage. The five countries fall into two broad groups, one exhibiting relatively high collection efficiency, and the other relatively low efficiency. While lack of detailed information on tax rules and consumption patterns makes definitive conclusions difficult, the impact of exemptions is shown to likely strengthen the comparative results.
