intent of this work is to

and regulation of use, and
the ultimate abolition of
the Canadian regulation
school strap. Over one
hundred former educators
were interviewed to
reconstruct actual trends
in practice and procedure.
Also included is a
thorough look at

manufacturers, suppliers,
models, specifications and
estimated market values
for those interested in
acquiring a real piece of
educational history. This
book discusses how our
school CP practice was
necessarily interwoven
with world, judicial and
parental CP influences.
Included is a detailed
study of one school
punishment book to
answer the questions of
whether its application
delivered any measurable
result for any kind of
behaviour, to what extent
that result was observed,
and if that result
confirmed or contradicted
popular opinion. Answers
are provided to questions
such as; is there empirical
proof of CP's
effectiveness? Does CP
save lives? This book
includes an account of all
the typical opinions on the
matter, why studies
contradict each other and
empirical world trends,
popular myths and
misconceptions about CP,
the differences between
judicious CP and abuse or

**The Power of Power

This ethnographic account of seafarers considers issues of transnationalism in the twenty-first century and discusses the detailed life experiences of migrant workers in this context. It argues for a consideration of the social space available to transnational migrant workers and suggests that the transnational experiences of migrants may be more likely to involve exclusion and alienation than an expansion of social space as a result of bi-location in more than one community. Based upon original qualitative research in three different settings, the book draws upon voyages undertaken by the author on five different working cargo ships. It describes the situation of seafarers from Cape Verde and Ghana searching for work in northern Germany and considers the perspectives of women married to Indian seafarers resident in Goa and Mumbai. This highly readable book will be of interest to readers from a

variety of disciplines who are interested in ethnography, particularly in the fields of social sciences and humanities who are interested in issues of migration, transnationalism, work, the shipping industry and globalisation. It will also appeal to individuals with a connection to, or an interest in, the merchant navy.

A Slave : In Love Palala

In this study, the authors examined the process by which anti-tobacco laws and ordinances were implemented and enforced in seven states and 19 localities. Their findings indicated that state- and local-level clean indoor air laws were rarely enforced by government agencies. Instead, these laws were largely self-enforcing, in that changed social norms regarding appropriate smoking behavior have led to high compliance rates. In contrast, teen access laws were consistently and vigorously enforced, mainly through periodic vendor compliance checks that were conducted in many of the sites visited. The authors also found that anti-tobacco forces do not devote a significant amount of

resources to implementation and enforcement issues. Rather, their attention is focused on enacting new legislation and fighting tobacco industry attempts to weaken existing laws through, for example, state preemption of local ordinances. Finally, the authors found that local enforcement is a critical ingredient to the success of virtually any tobacco control effort. The study's results do not augur well for public health measures that require state-level enforcement that are opposed by powerful and politically well-connected interests. To be effective, legislation must contain specific enforcement measures, such as license removal by local authorities.
