The Flute Concerto was written, in fact, for Holger Gilbert Jespersen, a francophile with a predilection for refinement and delicacy. This is reflected in the smaller orchestral forces for which Nielsen wrote, the light tracery of some of the flute's key lines and the pared fingernail daintiness.
