Drawing pictures of any information enable kids to remember it longer than writing or crafting mental images, and observing pictures of the objects depicted by the words. Develops problem-solving skills :- Doodling is the artistic process that enhances problem-solving skills in children. To draw lines on paper and associate them with colors and figures kids learn to imagine different solutions and perceive problem-solving from different perspectives. Drawing mind maps to recollect and remember what is learned is one of the most effective ways to demonstrate an understanding of any topic. When kids create a mind map, they are able to collect and organize data to solve a given problem more effectively. Conclusions : Drawing is one of the most entertaining and relaxing activities for kids. Let children doodle freely and express themselves fearlessly. According to research students remember 45 percent of the information they draw, while only 20 percent of things they wrote.
