### Decision Making Under Risk and Uncertainty Springer

Consider the problem of a robot (algorithm, learning mechanism) moving along the real line attempting to locate a particular point  $x$ . To assist the mechanism, we assume that it can communicate with an Environment ("Oracle") which guides it with information regarding the direction in which it should go. If the Environment is deterministic the problem is the "Deterministic Point Location Problem" which has been studied rather thoroughly [1]. In its pioneering version [1] the problem was presented in the setting that the Environment could charge the robot a cost which was proportional to the distance it was from the point sought for. The question of having multiple communicating robots locate a point on the line has also been studied [1, 2]. In the stochastic version of this problem, we consider the scenario when the learning mechanism attempts to locate a point in an interval with stochastic (i. e., possibly erroneous) instead of deterministic responses from the environment. Thus when it should really be moving to the "right" it may be advised to move to the "left" and vice versa. Apart from the problem being of importance in its own right, the stochastic point location problem also has potential applications in solving optimization problems. In many optimization solutions—for example in image processing, pattern recognition and neural computing [5, 9, 11, 12, 14, 16, 19], the algorithm works its way from its current solution to the optimal solution based on information that it currently has. A crucial question is one of determining the parameter which the optimization algorithm should use.

As desired, the information demand correspondence is single valued at equilibrium prices. Hence no planner is needed to assign information allocations to individuals. Proposition 4. For any given information price system  $p \in P(F^*)$ , almost every  $A$  demands a unique combined information structure (although traders may be indifferent among partial information sales from different information allocations, etc. ). In particular, the aggregate excess demand correspondence for net combined information trades is a continuous function. Proof Uniqueness fails only if an agent can obtain the same expected utility from two or more net combined information allocations. If this happens, appropriate slight perturbations of personal probability vectors destroy the equality unless the utility functions and wealth allocations were independent across states. Yet, when utilities and wealths don't depend on states in  $S$ , no information to distinguish the states is desired, so that the demand for such information structures must equal zero. To show the second claim, recall that if the correspondence is single valued for almost every agent, then its integral is also single valued. Finally, note that an upper hemicontinuous (by Proposition 2) correspondence

Although coercion is a fundamental and unavoidable part of our

social lives, economists have not offered an integrated analysis of its role in the public economy. The essays in this book focus on coercion arising from the operation of the fiscal system, a major part of the public sector. Collective choices on fiscal matters emerge from and have all the essential characteristics of social interaction, including the necessity to force unwanted actions on some citizens. This was recognized in an older tradition in public finance which can still serve as a starting point for modern work. The contributors to the volume recognize this tradition, but add to it by using contemporary frameworks to study a set of related issues concerning fiscal coercion and economic welfare. These issues range from the compatibility of an open access society with the original Wicksellian vision to the productivity of coercion in experimental games.
