In this new century mankind faces ever more challenging environmental and public health problems, such as pollution, invasion by exotic species, the emergence of new diseases or the emergence of diseases into new regions (West Nile virus, SARS, Anthrax, etc.), and the resurgence of existing diseases (influenza, malaria, TB, HIV/AIDS, etc.).
