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 Line-of-Sight Propagation Above 30 MHz neither ground nor sky wave propagation operates  
 Transmitting and receiving antennas must be within line of sight  
 Satellite communication - signal above 30 MHz not reflected by ionosphere  
 Ground communication - antennas within effective line of site due to refraction  
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 RADIO PROPAGATION MODELS - Wireless Communication  
 Wireless transmissions propagate in three modes: ground-wave, sky-wave, and line-of-sight. Ground wave propagation follows the contour of the earth, while sky wave propagation uses reflection by both earth and ionosphere. Finally line of sight propagation requires the transmitting and receiving antennas to be within line of sight of each other.
