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relations, Linklater and others argue that it is the dialogue between Realism and Marxism that provides the necessary starting point for a critical theory of international relations. This means that understanding the ways one is oppressed enables one to take action to change oppressive forces. Critical social science makes a conscious attempt to fuse theory and action. Critical theories are thus normative; they serve to bring about change in the conditions that affect our lives.

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
