Rather shall we endeavour to pick out the common ailments from which practical experience has taught us any dog may suffer, leaving more obscure diseases, with which the dog owner is less likely to be confronted, to the skilled attention of the vet. It will also be our object to endeavour as far as possible to recommend such medicines and treatment as are within the reach of all, elaborate concoctions not coming within the province of practical treatment.
